

LOUISIANA ATTORNEY DISCIPLINARY BOARD

ORDER

Considering the devastation caused by Hurricane Ida, including road closures, damage due to high winds and flooding, and the loss of power and water in many areas of the state; for the safety of the public and the Disciplinary Board staff;

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Disciplinary Board office (previously closed from August 30, 2021 through September 2, 2021 due to the effects of Hurricane Ida) will remain closed through September 19, 2021. All filings due on August 30, 2021 through September 19, 2021 shall be deemed timely filed if filed on September 20, 2021; and

All hearings and telephone conferences currently set during this period of closure are continued, to be reset in due course after September 20, 2021. The Disciplinary Board will notify the parties of the resetting of their hearings and telephone conferences after September 20, 2021; and

In re Miles, 21-DB-020, currently set for a telephone conference on September 14, 2021 and for hearing on September 20, 2021, is continued, to be reset in due course after September 20, 2021. The Disciplinary Board will notify the parties of the resetting of the hearing and telephone conference after September 20, 2021; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

During this period of closure, the Disciplinary Board will handle emergency matters as necessary.
