The Louisiana Attorney Disciplinary Board (LADB), an agency of the Louisiana Supreme Court, is seeking to fill an upcoming vacancy in the position of Board Counsel. Key responsibilities for this attorney position include:

- Provide legal assistance and guidance on all matters pending before the Board's Adjudicative Committee;
- Supervise case management/docketing functions for matters pending before the Board's Adjudicative Committee;
- Provide assistance to Board Administrator and General Counsel, as needed, on other Board matters;
- Conduct legal research and draft memoranda or other reports for Board use;
- Assist with preparation of the Board's monthly e-newsletter; and
- Assist with preparation for and implementation of the Board's Continuing Legal Education programs.
