

PER CURIAM

Respondent pleaded guilty to one count of conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute controlled substances. Prior to the filing of formal charges, respondent and the Office of Disciplinary Counsel submitted a joint petition for consent discipline in which respondent admitted that he violated Rules 8.4(a) and 8.4(b) of the Rules of Professional Conduct. Having reviewed the petition,

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Consent Discipline be accepted and that Brian Allen Miller, Louisiana Bar Roll number 40143, be and he hereby is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three years. This suspension shall be retroactive to February 1, 2024, the date of the imposition of suspension in *In re: Miller*, 24-0141 (La. 2/1/24), 420 So. 3d 1, and subject to the conditions set forth in the petition for consent discipline.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all costs and expenses in the matter are assessed against respondent in accordance with Supreme Court Rule XIX, § 10.1, with legal interest to commence thirty days from the date of finality of this court's judgment until paid.
