

PER CURIAM

The Office of Disciplinary Counsel (“ODC”) commenced an investigation into allegations that respondent violated Rules 1.3 and 1.4 of the Rules of Professional Conduct. Prior to the filing of formal charges, respondent and the ODC submitted a joint petition for consent discipline. Having reviewed the petition,

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Consent Discipline be accepted and that Carol Savant Loy, Louisiana Bar Roll number 31502, be publicly reprimanded. It is further ordered that respondent shall attend the Louisiana State Bar Association’s Ethics School.
